# Grosso Marshmallow Pillow

## Designed by Helen Firing for Estelle Yarns

**Difficulty Level:** Advanced Beginner  
Knitters must be able to work in the round

**Size and Finished Measurements:**  
One size, stretches to fit 16" pillow form  
Approximately 28" circumference by 14" tall

**Materials:**  
2 200g/20m Borgo de' Pazzi Grosso (sample shown in col 1)  
1 24" circular 20mm/US size 36 needle, piece of scrap yarn to use as marker  
Optional: approx. 2 yards matching yarn in dk or worsted wt and yarn needle for sewing up  
16" square pillow form

**Gauge:** 3.5 sts x 7 rows = 4 ins/10 cm in stocking st on 20mm/US size 36 needles

**Method:**  
Using the backward-looping method, cast on 24 sts.  
Knit 1 row.  
Join for working in the round, being careful not to twist sts. Place marker.  
Knit 17 rounds.  
Cast off.

**Finishing:**  
With RS (knit) facing, flatten tube to create a square. Using rem Grosso or matching yarn, sew together 2 sides of cast on edge. Turn work inside out (so purl side is showing) and insert pillow form. Sew together 2 sides of cast off edge. Bury ends inside pillow.

OR  
For another look, turn work inside out and sew first edge with purl side facing. Turn work again so knit side faces out and insert pillow form. Sew final edge together. Bury ends inside pillow.
